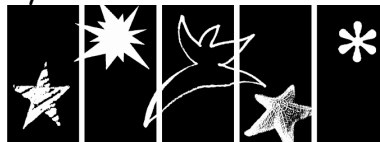

Children's Theatre Workshop 2009 - Policies and Procedures

Workshop Content: Children will participate in introductory theatre lessons including singing, dance, mask making, puppetry, pantomime, basic acting and improvisation, and arts & crafts activities. The schedule will vary daily and might be cumulative, therefore students will probably wish to attend both sessions.

Introductory Presentation: There will be a presentation on the history of children's theatre given on Thursday July 23rd at 7:30 pm for all interested parents.

Behavior Management: It is expected of all participants to act in a responsible manner at all times displaying respect, caring, and honesty to other children and the TCS staff. In cases of disputes or conflicts the staff will give participants every opportunity to calmly resolve the situation. As part of the resolution process children may be asked to remove themselves from the current activity to calm down and reflect on his or her actions. TCS staff will review the rules and expectations of participants with them at the workshop. Repeated failure to adhere to these expectations can/will result in suspension or termination from the workshop. Refunds will NOT be issued in the event of suspension or termination.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up: The workshop begins promptly at 8:30 a.m. The earliest children should arrive is 8:15. TCS staff will not be available to supervise children before that time. The workshop ends promptly at 3:00 p.m. When picking up a workshop participant all persons must present a pick up pass and matching picture ID, including parents. Pick up passes will be included in the confirmation packet.

Confirmation Packet: After your registration form and tuition has been processed, you will receive a confirmation packet which includes medical information and emergency contact forms, liability release and permission to photograph form, and pick- up passes.

First Aid: While we do not contact parents for minor scrapes and scratches that require only cleaning and a band-aid, we will contact you if your child suffers a more serious injury or accident. In case of illness you will be contacted to pick up your child from the workshop. In an emergency your child will be transported to the nearest hospital by ambulance.

TCS Staff: TCS staff members are experienced in many and various forms of theatre. Our goal is to impart the joy and love of theatre to each participant in a safe, fun, nurturing environment. We want all children to have a positive, rewarding experience at the Children's Theatre Workshop. To maintain our safety standards all TCS staff present at the workshop are CORI investigated. Lunch: Each day there will be a lunch break. Participants must provide their own food and beverages for lunch. Water will be available for the duration of the workshop. PEANUT PRODUCTS ARE NOT ALLOWED!!

Auditions: On Sunday 16 August at 6:00 PM there will be Auditions for children in our fall musical production of *The Wizard of Oz*. Students in the workshop will be prepared to tryout, primarily for the various *Munchkin* roles. (If there are schedule conflicts, children may also audition on Monday or Tuesday 17 or 18 August at 7:30 PM.)
